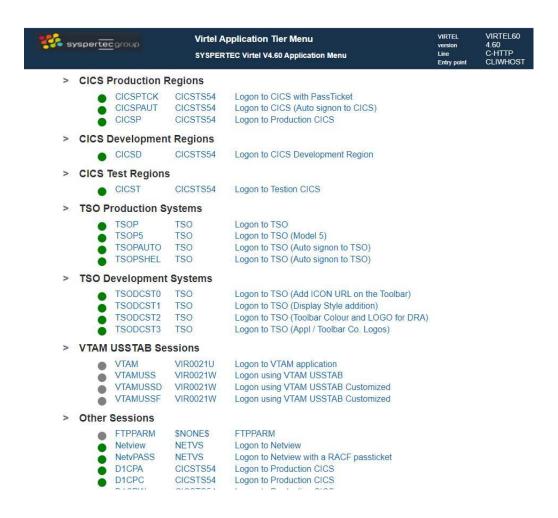

### Tip of the Month #1

### **Application Tier Menu**

Virtel V4.59 and V4.60 feature a new application tier menu whose look and ergonomics – when combined with SSO and web browsers multi-tab/multi-instance capability – provide a functionality like that of third-party session managers. In an upcoming version due by yearend 2020, the tier menu sections will collapse or expend when clicking on the section headers. Replacing third-party session managers with Virtel's integrated session management facility will eliminate the associated licensing and support costs.





### Tip of the Month #2

To automatically pass user credentials (user-id and password) to a TSO session using a TIOA, update the TSO transaction or create a new one with the following parameters:

## Concurrent iPV4/IPV6 Support

SysperTec has developed concurrent IPV4/IPV6 support. For Virtel connections Beta testing is in progress. General availability is planned for end of January 2021.

### Virtel Web Modernization

SysperTec is in the process of redesigning, and will soon start redeveloping, their Virtel GUI IDE.

The current IDE supports basic field to widget conversion, but the user interface is outdated, and the list of supported widget needs to be expanded. The current IDE also doesn't provide user-friendly redesign of the GUI pages layout: it currently requires web development skills.

The new IDE will support both expanded field to widget conversion and GUI page layout redesign in a user-friendly (WYSIWYG) user interface that won't require web development skills.

SysperTec has developed a survey to ask prospective Virtel Web Modernization customers about their requirements and expectations for the new IDE.
