## SDS E-Business Server® Product Entitlement Definitions

An SDS E-Business Server license is based on one or more of these definitions; refer to your Grant Letter and License Agreement.

**CPU** Central Processing Unit. The CPU is the primary component of a computer that processes

instructions from a computer's programs. The CPU contains at least one processing core

(CPU core), which is the actual chip inside the CPU that performs calculations.

**CPU Core** A single, independent physical processing unit (execution core) within a CPU. For virtual

machines, this will be equal to the number of CPU cores reported by the guest operating

system.

**LPAR** Logical Partition. A logical segmentation of a mainframe's memory and other resources that

allows it to run its own copy of the operating system and associated applications. LPARs are

caused by special hardware circuits and allow multiple system images to run in one

machine. This can be multiple instances of the same operating system or different operating

systems.

MIPS Millions of Instructions Per Second. A unit of measuring the processing power of different

types of computers.

## **License Types**

Production License Allows a customer to download, install, maintain, and operate E-Business

Server in the regular operating environment.

Non-Production License Allows a customer to copy E-Business Server, then install and use it for

development and testing purposes.

Evaluation License Allows a potential customer to install and use E-Business Server for a

specified time period for the purpose of evaluating the software.

Full License Allows a customer to install and use E-Business Server on the following

distributed platforms: AIX, HPUX, Linux, Solaris, Windows. Licensed per CPU.

Partner License Allows a customer to install and use E-Business Server on the following

distributed platforms: AIX, HPUX, Linux, Solaris, Windows. Licensed per CPU. This license has a limitation of only one public key other than its own to

exchange files with only one partner.

z/OS License Allows a customer to install and use E-Business Server on z/OS. Licensed per MIP.
