## **SDS E-Business Server® Export Controls**

Exports and re-exports of SDS products are subject to U.S. export controls and sanctions administered by the Commerce Department's Bureau of Industry and Security (BIS) under the U.S. Export Administration Regulations (EAR).

This document provides export control information on SDS software products. SDS products provide encryption features that are subject to the EAR and other U.S. laws. These features have been approved for export from the United States, subject to certain requirements and limitations.

You are responsible for exporting or re-exporting SDS software in accordance with U.S. law. We encourage you to seek appropriate legal advice and/or consult the EAR and the BIS Information Technology Controls Division before exporting, re-exporting, or distributing SDS software. The information provided here is subject to change without notice.

## **Embargoed Destinations**

SDS products may not be exported or re-exported, either directly or indirectly, to any country embargoed by the United States, or to any country considered by the United States as a supporter of international terrorism, without proper authorization from the U.S. government. ## U.S. Prohibited and/or Restricted Lists

SDS products may not be sold, exported, or re-exported to any person or entity designated as prohibited or restricted by an agency of the U.S. government. Exports to companies, organizations, or persons listed on the Specially Designated Nationals List, the Debarred List, the Entity List, and other governmental lists are prohibited.

## **Enhanced Proliferation Control Initiative**
